DOUBLE FOREIGNER made a bid for the lead on the final turn and weakened in the drive. NOT BAD showed speed and dropped back. VINTAGE CLASS led the final turn, weakened and left the course approaching the final hurdle. MOZO ALEGRE (CHI) left course. BROTHER weakened and left the course. BLASPHEMOUS stumbled and lost his rider.
