I'VEGOTHEMUSICINME , steadied when breaking inward, saved ground around the turn and showed a late response. WHAT DO I DO , swung outside in upper stretch, weakened. NAGEM NAGEM NAGEM , wide, gave way. COUNTESS BAREEQ dropped back. ITS MY OPTION , fractious in the starting gate, stopped after being steadied in traffic entering the turn.
