Footnotes

BUD BOYLE , angled to the rail entering the far turn, was steadied near the five sixteenths pole, slipped through along the rail entering the stretch, raced erratically in midstretch and prevailed under energetic urging. LIKNOTHINUEVERSEEN set the pace off the rail, drifted very wide in midstretch and finished willingly. STONESTREET STAR lacked speed, swung very wide in upper stretch and had a slight rally. ACROSS , unhurried early, was checked on the heels of rivals approaching the stretch then failed to rally. ROAD TO ARIVACA chased the pace, was four wide entering the stretch and gave way. BLUNDER BAY chased the pace, circled four wide turning for home and gave way. FELAND'S LAW , fractious during the post parade, was outrun. SOUTHERN CAVALIER stumbled leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail and was no factor. CJ'SSPECIAL , no factor, swung wide entering the stretch. IM A TIGGER TOO saved ground chasing the pace, drifted out entering the stretch and faltered.
