HIT ANOTHER GEAR settled early towards the inside, eased out and advanced three wide leaving the five sixteenths marker, swung out seven wide at the head of the lane, closed determinedly under pressure and got up at the wire. WESTMORELAND , four wide into the backstretch, angled in and lodged a two wide bid nearing the half mile marker, moved to a short lead after three quarters, took pressure through the lane, battled gamely but was nailed on the wire. IMPERIAL GIN settled off the rail, advanced mid way on the final turn, angled five wide for the drive and rallied between rivals. INSTINCTIVELY rated towards the inside early, angled out and lodged a three wide bid around the far turn, disputed the issue outside WESTMORELAND to deep stretch and hung. DAWNS FEARLESS SON lagged early, advanced five wide past the three eighths pole, angled out a bit wider and closed the gap between horses. RAWLEY stalked the pace towards the inside, angled out in deep stretch but lacked the needed punch. WARACHA , within range while off the rail, moved up four wide into the far turn, loomed into the lane then came up empty late. YOUNGBLOOD was sent three wide to go clear early, dropped in to set the pace, was joined after four and a half furlongs, relinquished command nearing the five sixteenths pole, held well to upper stretch then steadily gave way. ROGERSVILLE , rank early, failed to menace. INDIAN WAR forced the early pace while saving ground then tired.
