Footnotes

SHOW US RYAN set the pace along the rail, drew off in upper stretch and just lasted while continuing on his left lead. IMPERIAL GIN angled in to the two path entering the first turn, eased four wide leaving the three-eighths pole, shifted further out near midstretch and surged outside to just miss. ELDOKTORI was unhurried inside early, tipped three wide nearing the far turn, made a mild advance while in hand around that bend, angled to the rail in upper stretch, was roused near the three-sixteenths pole, closed well inside then angled back out late. BUSTER DOUGLAS prompted the pace two wide, bid nearing the lane and faded in the final sixteenth. BUCKLE DOWN DARLIN raced three wide between around the first turn, advanced between foes around the far turn and flattened out. MUDDY MULLINS saved ground and faded. HERR MOZART steadied along while racing four wide early, steadied nearing the far turn, advanced three wide between foes around that bend then weakened in the drive. KINDA KATTY was hung five and six wide around the first turn, bid five wide around the far turn and tired in the drive. SILENT KNIGHT saved ground and never factored. RUN TO THE SUN stalked the pace from the rail and was done after a half. TREY BEAR chased the pace three and four wide and retreated around the far turn.
