Footnotes

BOLTIN' OUT , bumped at the break, was sent up between rivals soon after to grab command, edged clear nearing the turn, set a rated pace towards the inside, responded when asked in upper stretch and eagerly widened while under steady hand pressure. COOL HEART , outrun early while off the rail, circled five wide into the stretch and kept on willingly to gain the place. CAPTAIN HENRY , bumped at the break, saved ground in an even effort. JUST BEARABLE was rated back off the winner nearing the turn, angled out, circled four wide making a slight move into the lane then faded. BOPING ALONG chased the pace two wide and weakened. MY KNIGHT SPECIAL , three wide between rivals mid turn, lacked a bid. SACHICOMULA broke a step slow, was sent up between rivals into the turn, chased and faded.
