MORNING HIGH set the pace near the rail and prevailed in an extended drive. RAINBOWS AND ROSES, six wide, rallied. MINNIEPRIZE lacked speed, raced in the seven path in the stretch and closed. BREEZY BRI saved ground and was steadied approaching the wire. SHE'S NO TEN lacked speed and raced in the six path in the stretch. TIME FOR A CURE raced five wide and weakened. HAWK N THE SHEIKH raced in the three path, was in tight quarters in upper stretch then surrendered. FRILLS AND RIBBONS pressed the pace outside the winner and gave way. WHATEVER SHEWANTS, four wide in upper stretch, lugged in near the three sixteenths pole and gave way. SUPER PUNCH gave way.
