OUTER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. Early closing May 21, 2007, at a fee of \$100. Late nominations close Monday July 9, 2007, at a fee of \$500. \$950 to pass the entry box. \$950 additional to start with \$200,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$75,000 at one mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; \$50,000 at one mile or over, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 at one mile or over, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Early nominations closed Monday, May 21, 2007 with 66 nominations. Late nominations closed Monday, July 9, 2007 with 11 nominations. Trophy to the owner of the winner.

Footnotes

DREAMING OF ANNA , quickly went clear, set a rated pace along the inside, took some pressure while still under rating nearing the quarter pole, edged back clear in upper stretch, responded to right handed urging leaving the three sixteenths marker, was put to left handed encouragement near the sixteenth pole, drifted out a bit then dug in tenaciously under steady handling late. NEW EDITION stalked the pace three wide, steadily advanced nearing the quarter pole, closed gamely but just wasn't quite good enough. CHRISTMAS KID prompted the pace two wide, lodged a bid between rivals nearing the lane then was outfinished in the final furlong. BIT OF WHIMSY stumbled at the break then steadied when in tight soon after, pulled four wide between rivals into the backstretch, continued in range while wide leaving the five eighths pole, angled in a bit around the final turn, raced between rivals into the lane and kept trying to the finish. SNOW CONE , unhurried early, raced between rivals leaving the far turn, swung out six to seven wide in upper stretch and closed willingly. LEMONLIME was steadied off heels around the first turn, settled back a bit down the backstretch, steadied again leaving the far turn, made a three to four wide run nearing the lane then lacked the needed finish. ARDNAVAGH (FR) saved ground, had a mild stretch response but never threatened.

SWINGIT lacked speed off the rail, came five wide for the drive and failed to respond. CIAO lost ground four and five wide and lacked a rally. CABBAGE KEY , very wide in upper stretch, was not a factor. SUPER SLASH saved ground, stalked the pace to the quarter pole and gave way. SILENCE DOGOOD was steadied along between rivals around the first turn, was urged along two wide nearing the quarter pole then tired.
