FREX broke slowly, checked while wide near the five eighths pole, recovered and circled the turn four wide, rallied under left handed urging, moved to command nearing the furlong marker, kicked clear then held sway late. BADGER'S DRIFT, away forwardly, was shuffled back near the five furlong marker, steadied early turn, swung out six wide for the drive and closed gamely to just get the place. YOUR BUSTED, taken to rate between rivals while off the rail, advanced three wide into the lane, angled to the five path past the furlong grounds and finished well between foes. SAFARI KING disputed the pace two wide to mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. TRAVISION broke slowly, circled four wide into the lane and had some belated action. SILVER NITRO set a pressured early pace along the rail, dueled from mid turn to upper stretch then gave way. SHOP SMART saved ground stalking the early pace and faded. HOLY MACKREL ANDY saved ground early, angled out mid turn and came up empty. WHISKEY KEG was steadied between rivals leaving the half mile marker. WHAT A TIGER broke outward, moved up four wide nearing the turn, stalked the leaders three wide to the head of the lane then tired. UNEXPECT PLEASURE dropped far back.
