REINE DE BONBON saved ground around the turn under patient handling, eased out to the two path in upper stretch, bumped with VINTAGE JEWEL approaching the eighth pole, split foes in midstretch then eagerly drew out while kept to her business. SALLY OH SALLY stalked the pace, raced wide on the turn and rallied outside horses. GATOR GONE WILD chased the pace four wide around the turn, had aim on the lead in midstretch then flattened out. ANNKATHRIN , wide on the turn, passed tired horses. CASUALLY PUT saved ground on the turn and was outrun. DANCNINTHELILLIES set a pressured pace along the rail and gave way in the drive. VINTAGE JEWEL , in the three path entering the turn, prompted the pace between horses, began to weaken in upper stretch, bumped with the winner in midstretch and faltered. ISLAND MEMORIES briefly prompted the pace two wide.
