HILDEGARDE , taken to rate while saving ground, edged closer in hand nearing the far turn, waited briefly near the quarter pole, angled out for room in upper stretch, forged four wide to command nearing the eighth pole, responded to right handed pressure, kicked clear then held firm. BUTTERDISH , patiently rated off the rail to the quarter pole, worked between rivals past the eighth pole and finished with good energy. CHARLI SUNSHINE tracked the pace towards the inside, eased out around the far turn, lodged a bid between rivals nearing the lane, dueled then gave way grudgingly. ART OF THE HUNT , unhurried while saving ground to the quarter pole, swung out, split rivals late and finished well. BELLA PROMESSA , in range under rating and off the rail, circled four to five wide into the lane but came up empty. ARTIE'S PARTY was sent up wide early, prompted the pace, moved three wide to press after a half mile, dueled on a short lead near the quarter pole, held well to the furlong grounds then weakened. SIMPLE SONGS failed to menace. TELL ME EVERYTHING set a slow pace towards the inside, took pressure into the far turn, dueled inside rivals entering the lane then faltered through the final three sixteenths. REMARKABLY WELL was steadied soon after the break, hustled up wide nearing the first turn, chased and faltered after a half mile.
