WE HOPE , unhurried early, raced wide entering the stretch, closed and drove clear. POR SUPUESTO , unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, gained a short lead near the sixteenth pole then weakened. WANNABE dueled two wide, opened a clear lead entering the stretch and tired late. COLE'S A PLAYER raced in the two path turning for home and failed to rally. TORNADO TRACK , three wide the far turn, was no factor. CAPO DEI CAPI saved ground, swung wide in upper stretch and failed to be a factor. SEND OFF FLYING was outrun. VALLEY TRAIL dueled along the rail and faltered.
