Footnotes

AMENHOTEP settled off the pace while saving ground around the turn, angled out in upper stretch, closed well under left-handed urging, took command late and won going away. FACSIMILE prompted the pace three wide, took the lead midway around the turn, drew clear in upper stretch, held clear past the sixteenth pole, drifted out under left-handed urging and could not resist the winner while holding clear for the place. STONEWALL KITCHEN stalked the pace from the rail and finished willingly. YOUCANCALLHIMITURK was bumped and forced to check soon after the start, rushed up to stalked the pace three wide, loomed in upper stretch then flattened out while continuing on his left lead. TRICKY BREAK chased the pace three wide between rivals and lacked the needed rally. WILD CAPTAIN BOB failed to menace while racing four wide. DRINKIN PROBLEM was bumped just after the start, rushed up to set the pace along the rail then tired nearing the lane. SURPRISEDTOSEEME was never a factor while racing four wide. PEACE DERESISTANCE was bumped just after the start and never a threat.
