CLASSIC TEN , hustled up between rivals into the turn, angled out four wide advancing nearing the lane, closed under strong left handed pressure, took command near the sixteenth marker and drew out. MESSALINA tracked three wide under rating, moved to challenge in upper stretch, kicked clear a furlong out, continued willingly but was second best. FLOWERMING , bumped at the break, was hustled along four wide mid turn, shifted out wider in upper stretch and rallied mildly. TEXAS FLEETING saved ground early, swung out six to seven wide for the drive and had some belated action. LOOK chased the pace two wide around the turn and gave way. RAFFIAN broke slowly, raced wide and failed to menace. HONEYLYN , bumped at the break, raced wide in the lane and was not a factor. FORT BROOK FIELDS chased towards the inside and gave way. SMOOCH TIME set the pace two wide to upper stretch and weakened.
