ADIRONDACK FOREST stalked the pace, moved closer into the far turn, closed steadily four to five wide under right handed pressure, took command in deep stretch then prevailed. PRIMERO PERU saved ground throughout and closed willingly to just miss. WERBEE opened up early, set a solid pace towards the inside, ducked out under left handed urging leaving the eighth pole, was straightened away soon after, battled between foes inside the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. SIR JOLLY ARTHUR , three to four wide early, made a mild advance past the eighth pole, shifted in and flattened out. PROPER EVENT failed to menace. HOEDOWN lacked speed while saving ground, angled out nearing the lane but lacked a solid response. WINDSOR COURT broke slowly and was outrun. NOTICE THE TRICK , three wide, drifted out entering the lane and tired.
