Footnotes

PERFECT MEASURE raced near the rail, disputed the early pace then eagerly pulled away through the stretch under a hand ride. COOKIE FACE bore out leaving the starting gate, circled the turn, chased the winner, drifted out entering the stretch and was best of the others. ICE THUMPER , two wide entering the stretch, was not a threat. C C'S PAL lacked speed, raced wide entering the stretch and passed tired horses. ICE ON THE SIDE saved ground and was not a factor. GRAEMY , wide around the turn, was no factor. TURN TIGER dueled outside the winner and gave way. GREAT PACK , very wide turning for home, was no factor. DANCING THE MAMBO gave way. GIVE GLORY TO GOD , bumped leaving the starting gate, swung wide entering the stretch and was outrun. CLEAN MUD was outrun. NO DOUBT , fractious in the starting gate, was bumped at the break then was outrun.
