SWEET ISSUE was unhurried while racing between rivals through the opening three-quarters, angled out in upper stretch, closed strongly to reach contention, battled briefly outside of DOLPHIN STAR approaching the sixteenth pole then drew clear late. DOLPHIN STAR (FR) saved ground while racing in mid pack, moved up inside around the far turn, launched a three-wide bid approaching the stretch, took the lead near the eighth pole, battled with the leader to the sixteenth pole, was no match for that rival late. EVA'S EVENT saved ground to the lane, angled out and rallied belatedly through the final eighth. COAL VALLEY closest to the pacesetter while racing along the rail through the opening half, dropped back around the far turn, finished with good energy along the rail through the final eighth. BLONDIES MIRACLE was never a factor while racing three and four wide. ITSNOTTHEMONEY chased the pacesetter while racing just outside of COAL VALLEY, weakened in upper stretch. STORMEY WONDER was fractious in the gate, rushed up to the lead, drew off down the backstretch, remained well clear to mid stretch then tired in the final eighth.
