ORDERED TO LISTEN stalked the pace, lodged a bid between rivals into the far turn, dueled along the inside into the lane, edged clear and won under a drive. BLONDESHAVEMORERUN stalked the pace, lodged a three wide bid nearing the half mile marker, dueled outside of the winner into the lane and stayed on well. SONIC CHARM was steadied at the break, moved up along the rail near the half mile marker, angled out and finished willingly. RECOVERING had some belated action. HAPPYHOLIDAYMAGIC was forced out nearing the first turn. RUMBLING TANK was forced out and steadied nearing the first turn. AFTERNOON JAZZ was forced out nearing the first turn, lost ground leaving the far turn, angled in and came up empty. MR FARNSWORTH , four wide near the half mile marker, stalked the issue leaving the far turn and gave way. IMPRESSIVE RETURN bore out early bothering rivals. AQUILA D'ORO , forced out early, lost ground five wide down the backstretch and gave way. ROMAN APPLE cleared early, checked when tiring leaving the far turn.
