OUTER TURF FOR TWO-YEAR OLDS (REGISTERED VIRGINIA BRED / VIRGINIA SIRE). No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Sunday, July 22, 2012 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees) \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weights: 120 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs; a race other than maiden or claiming on the turf 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest lifetime earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, July 18, 2012 with 18 nominations. (Rail at 95 feet). (S)

Footnotes

A LOVER'S QUESTION gained the lead outside VESTRY mid way on the turn, opened up entering the stretch and was ridden out. VESTRY broke alertly, sped to the early lead, hugged the rail, was no match for the winner and held the place. TUBAL , between horses on the turn, had a mild rally outside horses. A STREET , steadied along the rail entering the turn, swung out on the bend, entered the stretch in the three path, drifted in in midstretch and failed to rally. SKI POLE , wide around the turn, failed to rally. SNOWBALL FIGHT , a forward factor two wide on the turn, faltered in upper stretch. SMOKIN' BOOTS , three wide between horses entering the stretch, was steadied when trying to get out on the bend and failed to be a factor. PRIMAL GOLD was outrun. ORAPAX was outrun. PASS THE TAP was outrun after a sluggish start.
