Footnotes

I'M UNFORGETTABLE lacked speed in the two path early, circled five wide around the far turn, swept to command in midstretch and drew clear under a drive. CRYIN' RYAN stalked the pace from the rail, angled out in upper stretch, bid between foes in midstretch and was outfinished. NEW YORK HOLIDAY checked when in tight into the first turn, saved ground through the opening half, advanced three wide leaving the half-mile pole, waited for room from the five-sixteenths marker past midstretch, angled out and finished strongly to just miss second. PAIR set the pace along the rail, took some pressure around the far turn and weakened in midstretch. KIJO settled off the pace while racing inside and in the clear around the first turn, edged closer down the backstretch, bid three wide around the far turn and flattened out the lane. TREASURE TRIP failed to menace while racing two and three wide. DASHING MAX never factored while racing along the rail. COMEBACK PAPA stalked the pace two wide, advanced outside to apply some pressure to the pacesetter down the backstretch and tired around the far turn.
