CAMPAIGN VOWS moved up three wide entering the first turn and went clear, angled in and set a slow rated pace, turned away a challenge leaving the far turn, opened up when set down in upper stretch then held firm the final sixteenth while under solid handling. LUCKY LASS was rated along between rivals, angled in advancing into the stretch, rallied inside rivals past the furlong pole, eased back out a bit late and finished up well. CEE'S FAST saved ground under rating, moved closer into the far turn, eased out into the lane and kept on with interest. MAGICAL MERRY stalked the pace off the rail, moved up to threaten around the far turn, chased the winner into and through the lane and stayed on well. ANOTHER SMOKEY , taken to rate three wide, angled out and circled four wide into the stretch but lacked the needed finish. STACY ON THE WIRE , off the rail, failed to menace. FAVORED LADY saved ground and faded. HARD ROCKIN , three wide within range, edged a bit closer leaving the far turn, chased to the quarter pole then faltered.
