APRIL'S DIXIE BELL settled off the rail and off of a spirited pace, angled five wide into the lane, closed strongly under confident handling and forged ahead in the final yards. MISTY'S REBELLION dueled inside, shook clear in mid stretch and continued on gamely. CUT FOR LUCK saved ground mid turn, angled out and rallied mildly. GRAND LEE dueled between rivals, gained a short lead mid turn, continued to battle to the three sixteenths pole then weakened late. FOUND IN DARK broke slowly, saved ground mid turn and rallied mildly. MESSALINA vied three deep past the five sixteenths marker then gave way. READY TWO PUNCH chased the dueling leaders three wide and tired. ASKMETHEQUESTIONS chased four wide and faltered.
