JAKE'S LIL MAN hugged the rail, assumed the lead mid way on the far turn then drew off under urging. SENOR HABANERO , three wide the first turn, advanced in the two path between horses to reach a striking position mid way on the far turn, chased the winner and weakened. KENDALLS BEAR , swung to the three path turning for home, advanced to the three sixteenths pole then weakened. DASHING MAX , no factor, swung wide entering the stretch. UNFLAPABLE raced in the two path and was not a factor. BOW TIE saved ground and was outrun. DYLAN RAY sped to the front, set the pace in the three path and faltered.
