PRIVATE WHISPER , wide the far turn, narrowly prevailed in a hard drive. AWAD'S QUEST saved ground, swung wide in midstretch, bid inside the sixteenth pole then hung. MONKTON MISS lacked speed and rallied between horses. S S WINNIFRED , wide, failed to rally. JET BLACK MAGIC was no threat. STAMPEDEGIRL , very wide, was no factor. FOXY OLD CHARGER had speed along the rail and weakened. LONESOME TOO dueled two wide and gave way. LOTS OF PATS stalked the pace between horses and gave way. CAUGHT IN THE ACT lost ground on the turns and faltered.
