Footnotes

UPTOWN, taken to rate early while not far back and saving ground, eased off the inside leaving the far turn, moved between rivals mid way on the final turn, closed steadily outside foes while under left handed pressure and just got up. LA RECOLETA rated back off the lead around the first turn, tracked while inside, angled out in mid stretch, surged between rivals to be on near even terms in deep stretch, dueled and just missed. PAUPER'S QUEEN stalked the pace while off the rail, came under a ride leaving the three eighths pole, bid to challenge into the lane, dueled past the eighth pole, edged clear a sixteenth out, drifted in and just failed to last. PETITE LAFLEUR prompted the pace three to four wide, moved to command after a half mile, edged clear mid way on the final turn while moving in towards the rail, was collared entering the stretch, dueled inside PAUPER'S QUEEN in mid stretch then could not go with the top three in the final sixteenth. READY SET GO settled within range off the inside, was asked four wide nearing the lane but failed to respond. CLASS SKY LIMIT moved clear around the first turn through a soft opening quarter mile, dueled inside PETITE LAFLEUR past the half mile marker, continued a forward presence chasing to the head of the lane then gave way. CLASS HEX saved ground early and was outrun.
