INNER TURF FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD (REGISTERED VIRGINIA BREDS / VIRGINIA SIRE). No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, July 27, 2011 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees) \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-year-olds 118 lbs.; Older 124 lbs.; Non-winners of a Sweepstakes in 2011 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice over a mile in 2010-2011, 4 lbs.; \$21,000 on the turf since May 25, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2010-2011. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations closed on Thursday, July 21, 2011 with 25 nominations. (Rail at 25 feet). (S)

Footnotes

SILVER TIE AFFAIR settled off the pace along the rail, began a slight gain down the backstretch, moved up inside around the far turn, got through the in upper stretch, quickly swept to command nearing the three-sixteenths pole, dug in when nearly headed in midstretch, kicked clear nearing the sixteenth pole and edged away under a vigorous hand ride. CHEDI brushed with POWDER MOUNTAIN soon after the start, settled in mid pack while racing three wide around the first turn, angled in to save some ground early on the far turn, angled back out near the five-sixteenths pole, came five wide into the lane, loomed boldly in midstretch but was out kicked by the winner in the final sixteenth. POWDER MOUNTAIN brushed with CHEDI soon after the start, was caught four wide around the first turn, continued three and four wide while between foes around the far turn, came six wide into the lane, bumped with WHISKEY KEG in upper stretch and rallied for the show. FRISKY THUNDER raced two wide between foes around the first turn, advanced three wide into the far turn, bid between rivals in upper stretch but flattened out. SWAGGER JACK saved ground, exchanged bumps with JAKE'S LIL MAN down the backstretch, bid two wide between around the far turn, took the lead midway around the bend then weakened in the drive. BABY TIME saved ground and failed to menace. JAKE'S LIL MAN was three wide around the first turn, bid between rivals down the backstretch, exchanged bumps with SWAGGER JACK nearing the far turn, remained close up around the turn then tired in the drive. WHISKEY KEG lacked speed speed, raced four wide around the far turn, came seven wide into the lane, bumped with POWDER MOUNTAIN in upper stretch and lacked a rally. EL PISTON set the pace along the rail and faltered in the stretch.
