INNER TURF FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD (REGISTERED VIRGINIA BREDS / VIRGINIA SIRE). No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, July 27, 2011 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees) \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-year-olds 119 lbs.; Older 124 lbs.; Non-winners of a Sweepstakes in 2011 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice in 2010-2011, 4 lbs.; \$21,000 on the turf since March 7, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2010-2011. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations closed on Thursday, July 21, 2011 with 23 nominations. (Rail at 25 feet). (S)

Footnotes

DEPUTY FLING rated comfortably off of a contested pace while saving ground, quickly gained along the inside nearing the lane, swung out for clear running in upper stretch, forged clear under mild hand urging in mid stretch, widened past the sixteenth marker and won with something left. MAGIC NORMAN was hustled up soon after the break and raced in closest pursuit of the dueling leaders, steadily advanced under solid hand urging nearing the lane, altered out about four wide in upper stretch then chased the winner home while second best. SIMMSTOWN settled back early while towards the inside, eased off the inside and moved up a bit nearing the lane, advanced four wide between rivals in mid stretch, was guided back inside and finished with interest. JAKE RATTLE N ROLL was steadied off heels entering the turn, made some progress four wide nearing the lane then flattened out late. THAT'STHEQUESTION , outrun early, lost ground five wide into the lane and had some belated action. DESERT TIGER chased the pace, saved ground into the lane and came up empty. ROCK TO BOP dueled two wide through solid fractions, put a head in front mid turn, continued in front to the three sixteenths marker then succumbed in the final eighth. A KEEPER PARTNER , three wide between rivals chasing the pace, gave way in the drive. ERNEST T BASS , four to five

wide into the turn, had no impact. VALTER was outrun. MAJOR BOB was hustled out to a short lead, dueled along the inside through brisk fractions and tired leaving the three sixteenths marker.
