INNER TURF FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD (REGISTERED VIRGINIA BREDS / VIRGINIA SIRE). No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, July 27, 2011 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees) \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds 118 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2011 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010-2011, 4 lbs.; \$21,000 at a mile or over on the turf since May 15, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest turf earnings in 2010-2011. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations closed on Thursday, July 21, 2011 with 27 nominations. (Rail at 25 feet). (S)

Footnotes

EMBARR lagged along the inside through the opening three-quarters, angled out in upper stretch and closed with a rush. IN THE ROUGH stalked the pace two wide, bid two wide near the three-eighths pole, vied outside of RIVER FANCY to upper stretch, quickly spurred clear when roused with one right-handed tap in upper stretch, held clear under a moderate hand ride to deep stretch and was caught late. COBBLEY'S BREEZE was three wide around the first turn, angled in to save ground around the far turn, angled back out in upper stretch and finished evenly to preserve the show. LUNAR MIST lacked speed inside, was under a ride midway down the backstretch, continued to save ground around the far turn then made a mild belated rally. STAGED AFFAIR failed to menace while racing three wide. LISTENTOTHEWINDBLO never threatened while racing three and four wide. RIVER FANCY set the pace along the rail, duled inside of IN THE ROUGH from the three-eighths pole to upper stretch then tired in the lane. ANGEL I B stalked the pace three wide and tired in the lane. AUTUMN AFFAIR raced four wide throughout and faded.
