CROSS settled off the rail, advanced four wide around the final turn, gained a short lead in mid stretch, switched to her left lead and drew clear under a drive. ART SHOW prompted the pace three wide, lodged a bid leaving the three eighths pole, dueled into the lane and gave way grudgingly. COSMO QUEEN saved ground attending the pace, was pushed along mid way on the final turn, angled out but lacked a solid kick. LITTLE IDOL set the pace towards the inside and gave way nearing the furlong marker. SKIP TO THE WIRE saved ground early and failed to menace. THEORETICALAI stalked the pace between rivals and tired after five and a half furlongs.
