**Footnotes**

HOLD ON SMOKEY sprinted clear early, set a rapid pace inside while within himself, responded when called upon in mid stretch and dug in gamely to prevail. MCNAMARA , taken to rate while saving ground, moved up nearing the lane eased out for the final furlong, closed sharply and was getting to the winner. MACH THREE , unhurried early, steadily advanced along the rail into lane, shifted wide for the drive, continued a run to mid stretch then flattened out. DRUNKEN LOVE stalked the pace three wide, was put to strong urging mid turn, failed to seriously respond and faded in the final furlong. ABRAHAM LINCOLN (IRE) broke a step slow, rated off the rail, circled into the stretch and gave way. OFFICERONTHEMOVE chased the pace two wide to the quarter pole and tired.
