Footnotes

PIE TOWN , taken to rate early, moved up between rivals nearing the far turn, dropped in some advancing mid way on the final turn, worked his way back out four wide into the lane, closed under left handed pressure, collared TEN MISSIONS in deep stretch and was edging away late. TEN MISSIONS moved up steadily along the rail nearing the half mile marker, eased out five sixteenths out, rallied to command leaving the three sixteenths marker, opened a clear lead in mid stretch, was taken on late and gave way grudgingly inside the winner. OPENING MOVEMENT lacked speed, angled out six wide approaching the stretch and finished well. BALTIC AVENUE was briefly steadied around the first turn, lost ground four wide into the far turn, made some progress five wide in upper stretch then flattened out. GHOSTLY QUIET , in a bit tight along the rail around the first turn, was forced out about five wide near the half mile marker, angled in mid way on the final turn, shifted back out in the drive but lacked the needed finish. NARROW BACK opened up early then had his rider drop her left rein briefly near the quarter pole, recovered to set the pace to upper stretch, held well to the eighth pole then gave way. SUNEITAC was an early factor along the inside. CLASS BRAHMS was outrun. CASUAL AMOUR failed to menace. SIR JOLLY ARTHUR , four wide early, made a run nearing the half mile marker, chased then tired in upper stretch. STAR WON bore out briefly near the half mile marker forcing GHOSTLY QUIET wide and faltered.
