Footnotes

MAN MADE lacked speed, angled to the six path in midstretch, closed and was along in time. GRUMMAN stumbled soon after the break, raced five wide around the far turn, gained the lead in midstretch then gave way grudgingly. HELLO PROSPECTOR (BRZ) stalked the pace three wide and failed to rally. REMARKABLE stalked the pace and failed to sustain his bid. EL ESCORIAL dueled two wide between horses and weakened. SUNSHINE NUMBERS stalked the pace four wide and gave way. ONE MORE STORM, four wide the first turn, disputed the pace three wide down the backstretch and around the far turn and weakened in upper stretch. TUFF LOVER raced along the rail and weakened. I'M TELLING, outrun, raced seven wide entering the stretch. ROYAL ADMIRAL dueled along the rail and faltered. BARREN CREEK was outrun.
