WHERE'S MY NURSE rated close up off of a slow but contested pace, awaited room near the quarter pole, worked her way between rivals leaving the eighth pole, angled to the inside, closed determinedly under strong handling, took command late and prevailed. PING BAY had a three wide trip prompting the pace, lodged a bid leaving the far turn, dueled from the three eighths pole, gained a short lead in upper stretch and battled gamely to the wire. SHALL WE GATHER , three wide early, angled out four wide mid way down the backstretch, rallied four wide to challenge in upper stretch, dueled leaving the eighth pole and hung. MINNALOUSHE'S GIRL , taken back to rate early on, swung out six wide entering the lane and found her best stride too late. MORGAN'S FIELD gained a short lead between rivals into the backstretch, dueled from the three eighths pole to upper stretch, held well to the furlong marker and faded. LIGHT EVENT , never far back, came two wide for the drive and lacked a solid response. EASTERN STARLETT lost ground four wide around the first turn, continued wide to the far turn and failed to threaten. ROMANTIC FLIGHT disputed the pace along the rail and gave way leaving the five sixteenths marker.
