KONA BLEND broke outward, recovered and was sent up four to five wide to clear, angled in, set the pace under a light hold, responded to left handed urging in the lane and steadily widened. WYE stalked the winner and continued willingly to save the place. CRYPTOGRAM , a bit rank along the rail nearing the first turn, eased off the inside for the run down the backstretch, was urged along leaving the far turn, angled out four wide for the drive and closed willingly. MOUNT WEATHER saved ground, moved closer nearing the half mile marker, angled out three wide into the lane then came up empty in the final furlong. BEAN , wide early, angled in down the backstretch, continued inside for the drive but lacked a solid response. CLYDETHEGLYDE had no mishap and gave way. BLONDESHAVEMORERUN dropped back. BUSTER'S PRIDE stalked the pace, circled three wide around the final turn and tired in upper stretch.
