Footnotes

SWEET ISSUE circled the far turn, lugged in near the eighth pole and pulled away under a hand ride. M. E.'S SMILE raced inside horses to the stretch, swung wide in upper stretch and rallied. SHE CAN PUNCH , steadied lacking room along the rail midway on the far turn, rallied inside horses. BAYATTHEMOON dueled along the rail and weakened. MAKE IT LAST bore out leaving the starting gate, raced wide around the far turn and weakened. SHEZADIOS saved ground stalking the pace and gave way. BOLD FRENCHY was no factor. PRECISION PUNCH , steadied in tight quarters entering the first turn, raced three wide into the backstretch, prompted the pace two wide on the far turn and weakened in the drive. WEE BIT OF HEAVEN , wide the far turn, was no factor. NUN TOO NICE , used four wide on the first turn, drifted very wide entering the stretch and weakened. CYCLONE LASS was outrun. AUTUM PIE fell back. An objection by the rider of SHE CAN PUNCH against M.E.'S SMILE for alleged interference on the far turn was not allowed.
