DUBAI SUNDAY (JPN) quickly went clear soon after the start, held a long lead through the first circuit, came back to the field down the backstretch, kicked clear again turning for home and drew off under a drive to deep stretch then was taken in hand late. ONE SEA was unhurried while saving ground early, advanced outside down the backstretch, moved into a clear second turning for home, battled outside of EAGLE BEAGLE through the lane for the place and prevailed for that placing. EAGLE BEAGLE chased the winner from the inside through the first circuit, closed the gap down the backstretch, could not match strides with the top two nearing the lane but finished gamely inside of ONE SEA to just miss the place. JUNOOD rated off the pace while saving ground and lacked the needed rally. CUSE saved ground and never factored.
