Footnotes

NORTHERN FLAIR steadied behind rivals entering the first turn, rated patiently inside, swung out five wide for the drive, closed well and drew clear under pressure. SUNNY STRIKE set a slow pressured pace inside and held well. CAVEAT'S SHOT unhurried early, came wide for the drive and closed willingly. STANDING ALONE stalked the pace three wide, lodged a four wide bid to a short lead in upper stretch and was outfinished. MEXICALI ROSE saved ground, advanced in upper stretch, was brushed in mid stretch and lacked the needed bid. MAGIC DIALECT pressed the pace, vied between horses into the lane and faded. MOTEL LINKS unhurried early, circled five wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MRS POTTER (IRE) failed to menace. MADI LOU well placed, weakened.
