SOUTHERN SCHEMER raced five wide entering the stretch, closed and was along in time. GAL FROM DIXIE raced far off the rail down the backstretch, came six wide entering the stretch and rallied. LIEGE set the pace along the rail, weakened and her rider lost his right iron in deep stretch. LIMES 'N LEMONS raced inside horses on the far turn and passed tired rivals. HUMBLE saved ground on the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and lacked a bid. DYNAZONE prompted the pace two wide and gave way. DAME JANE stalked the pace three wide and gave way. PANDORA was outrun. DEFENSIVE BOAST raced wide the far turn and gave way. NITE CONFERENCE was outrun and very wide. JUMP SMARTLY saved ground and dropped back. ALMOST THERE was outrun. .
