ROYAL RIFF settled just off the early pace, rallied three wide on the turn, opened a clear lead in midstretch then held off TWO WHITE ROSES in the final sixteenth. TWO WHITE ROSES checked at the start, moved up under a snug old while saving ground, raced behind horses on the turn, angled out entering the stretch, made ad run to threaten in midstretch but couldn't overtake the winner. BARNEYS JOY lodged a mild rally four wide on the turn and flattened out. PREEMPTIVE BID set the pace under pressure into upper stretch and weakened. GOODBYE MY LUV forced the pace along the rail for five furlongs and tired.
