STORMY FROLIC stalked the pace along the rail, slipped through to take over on the far turn, then drew off under urging. CIUDAD DE CARSON quickly moved to the fore, made the pace off the rail to midway of the far turn, then was no match for the winner while holding the place. BEMA tracked the pace, raced four wide on the far turn and gained the show while no threat to the top ones. MS BROOKSKI outrun after bobbling at the start, raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. CELLARS SHIRAZ was outrun. PIANO CHIMES reserved while saving ground, faltered leaving the far turn. CUT A WAGER hit the gate at the start and was never a factor. MILLE FEVILLE chased the pace three wide into the far turn, then faded.
