STAKES Tropical Park Derby Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start - with \$100,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth.

Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 at a mile or over or two races at a mile or over other than maiden, claiming or starter, 5 lbs.; \$25,000 or a race at a mile or over other than Maiden, Claiming or Starter, 7 lbs. Graded placed horses of equal weights preferred. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. This race will be limited to 12 Starters, with Also Eligibles (High Weights Preferred). (1) Supplemental nomination of \$3,000 to enter and start. Closed Saturday, December 15, 2007 with (31) nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

Footnotes

COWBOY CAL prompted the pace outside JOEY THE SCHOLAR, moved to gain command from that rival midway of the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to maintain his advantage to the wire. WHY TONTO stalked the pace into the stretch and finished willingly to be up for the place. CANNONBALL reserved after hitting the gate at the start, rushed up along the hedge to reach the leaders entering the backstretch, was taken in hand to stalk those rivals around the far turn, eased outside JOEY THE SCHOLAR and advanced to reach the attending position in the stretch, then weakened. DYNHOCRACY outrun after stumbling at the start, was saving ground when steadied to avoid running up on CELESTIAL COMET on the far turn, found

room in the stretch and rallied to just miss the show. TITAN OF INDUSTRY off slowly, was rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and improved his position. MORAL COMPASS raced in striking position into the stretch, then tired. WISE ANSWER tracked the leaders four wide around the far turn and faltered. CELESTIAL COMET saved ground to no avail. JOEY THE SCHOLAR set the pace racing off the hedge, moved to the inside entering the far turn, then was fading when steadied at the top of the stretch. PIR AT THE MOON was not a factor. HEAVEN'S AWESOME was outrun. KIM'S DIXIE TUNE chased the leaders three wide into the far turn, then had nothing left.
