SOLE RUNNER set the pace off the rail into the stretch, then drew away when roused and was taken in hand in the final strides. SUN SCORPION stalked the pace along the rail into the stretch but was no match for the winner while gaining the place. CLOSING MAN rated in striking position off the pace, eased out for the drive and couldn't gain on the top one while up for the show. CELLARS CABERNET allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and closed some ground to just miss the show. DON BALCAZIO chased the winner three wide into the stretch and tired. MALIBU MIKE failed to menace after being outrun early. PRINCE JACK tracked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then faltered. ROCKCASTLE was not a factor. CASH US NOW saved ground and faded.
