Non-winners of \$35,000 twice at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 at a mile or over or two races at amile or over other than maiden, claiming or starter, 5 lbs.; \$25,000 or a race at a mile or over other than Maiden, Claiming, or Starter, 7 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning Owner. Closed Saturday, December 18, 2010 with 21 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth).

**Footnotes**

DYNAMIC HOLIDAY stalked the pace three wide, made a run to engage TRIUNE leaving the far turn, moved to gain a slim lead in the stretch, then was all out to just last over A BRILLIANT IDEA. The latter, rated off the pace, advanced four wide around the far turn, then responded to pressure in the drive and rallied to just miss. TRIUNE pressed the pace along the hedge, gained a slim lead on the far turn, responded when challenged by DYNAMIC HOLIDAY leaving the far turn, contested the pace with that rival to the sixteenth pole, then weakened. GREATEST DREAM up close racing along the hedge around the first turn, eased back on the backstretch, continued to save ground into the stretch, angled out and closed with a mild response. MICHELLE'S TRIP reserved off the pace, angled out for the drive and closed ground late. SWEET N NUTTY unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and never threatened. LEMONS TO LEMONADE tracked the pace along the hedge to the top of the stretch, then tired. BLUE ANGEL EXPRESS set the pace off the hedge into the far turn, continued on well to nearing the stretch after losing the lead, then faded.
