BROADWAY BOBBY Z set the pace along the inside into the stretch, then was fully extended to hold off CELLARS CABERNET. The latter, tracked the pace along the inside, was boxed in behind the winner around the far turn, eased out and was gaining slowly at the finish. FABULOUS TEXAS rated off the pace, raced four wide around the far turn and closed to gain the show. TANGO RIDGE outrun after being checked at the start, improved his position without threatening. BIRDCAPER chased the pace to the far turn and tired. CLOUDS OF FALCON chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faltered. BEACHMONT FASHION reserved early, advanced three wide around the far turn to reach contention, then faded in the drive. KADARKA was outrun while racing five wide.
