LOGAN SQUARE reserved early, rallied to catch SHE'S A SLEEPER in early stretch, then drew off while being kept to the task. DONAMIA unseated her rider when fractious in the gate, was outrun into the stretch, then closed well to be up for the place while no match for the winner. SHE'S A SLEEPER set the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. PARIS WEEKEND unhurried early, raced four wide around the far turn and passed tired rivals. REPUBLICAN stalked the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. MINNIE SUNSHINE rated off the pace, faltered. SWEET ENTICEMENT was not a factor. GOODGOLLYMYHOLLY broke through the gate prior to the start, tracked the pace along the inside into the far turn, angled out for the drive and faded. OUR PLUM PUTTING chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then had nothing left. U S S INCHON was caught in tight at the start, tracked the pace three wide to midway of the far turn, then dropped back. EMPRESS MARIA unseated her rider when fractious in the gate, then was outrun.
