A LITTLE OFF set the pace along the hedge, responded when headed by MISS MUFFIN on the far turn and regained the lead, then was fully extended to hold off OH MANDIE in a game effort. OH MANDIE stalked the pace along the hedge, angled out for the stretch run, made a run to try A LITTLE OFF through the final eighth but couldn't get by that rival. CALVARY CHARGE reserved off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied for the show. MISS MUFFIN broke through the gate prior to the start, was rated off the pace, rallied to gain a brief lead on the far turn, then tired in the drive. BON BON failed to menace after being caught in tight early. SUNRISE CRUISE chased the pace into the far turn and faltered. FIRST MANDATE was no factor after being caught in tight in the early going. BAHAMA DRAMA chased the pace into the far turn, then faded.
