Footnotes

ORSONIAN settled mid-pack, steadily advanced in the two to three path, dived to the rail in mid-stretch and surged late to prevail. SWIDGEN set the pace racing well clear, shortened stride in mid-stretch and weakened late. LANCE'S SONG settled off the pace, advanced four wide around the turn, continued to rally in the five or six path through the lane to capture show. FLY SOUTH chased the leaders in the three path, had no real late bid but maintained position through the lane while closing ground on the tiring leader. ANTONACCI raced close chasing the pacesetter in the two path early, had no late bid and finished evenly. VANISHING BUCK had no early speed, passed tiring foes late. THREEHIFIVES never threatened. STRONG FIRE chased inside, weakened.
