Footnotes

SOUTHERN DUNN settled off the pace racing inside a rival but off the rail, advanced to bid three to four wide leaving the far turn, prevailed under a drive. RHYTHM OF MY SOUL was hustled from the gate to duel inside a rival around the first turn before being taken back to a stalking position, moved to challenge that same rival, this time from outside, leaving the far turn, drifted in just prior to the eighth pole and bumped a foe, held place. BIG DEBBIE settled toward the rear early, cut the corner while advancing on the leaders, split foes in upper stretch, was bumped at the furlong marker by a drifting rival and forced into a foe inside while also steadying at that juncture, regained composure late to finish well. CLASSY AND SERENE was floated three wide on the first turn, raced outside and just off the flank of the winner down the backstretch, followed that one while swinging five wide into the lane, came up empty late. PLATINUM AND PLUSH was hard used from the gate to duel outside a rival around the first turn, cleared that foe leaving the first turn and set the pace along the inside in the clear, was bumped and then steadied in mid-stretch, tired. LEMONSINA received an inside trip but never threatened. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AS WELL AS AN OBJECTION LODGED BY THE RIDERS OF #6, PLATINUM AND PLUSH, AND #7, BIG DEBBIE, AGAINST THE UNOFFICIAL SECOND-PLACE FINISHER, #1, RHYTHM OF MY SOUL, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN MID-STRETCH, THE LATTER, WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED FIFTH.
