MONGOLIAN FRONT settled off the early pace, advanced in a four wide bid on the turn, wrested control in mid-stretch and prevailed under steady handling. AMERICAN PROUD hopped at the spotted the field a couple lengths from the start, steadily advanced up the inside to upper stretch at which point she was angled to the four path, continued to make up ground and got up for place. MADDIE O'S PRIZE was hustled from the gate and always forwardly placed, finished evenly to capture show honors. HENNY GIRL vied between runners early, had edged to a clear lead by the top of the lane, weakened. SOUP FOR SUPPER had no speed racing inside to the lane, shifted off the rail and gained mildly. LASTOCHKA raced far back early, passed tiring foes late. VIZCAYA STAR attended the pace three wide, faltered. YOUR SISTER vied for the early lead inside rivals, gave way.
