Footnotes

PUTY BOY was away alertly and just off the flank of the early pacesetter for the opening furlong and a half but was then taken back off the pace to a stalking position alone and in the clear, continued that way down the backstretch, edged closer leaving the far turn, cut the corner and found room to move up inside the pacesetters, vied with those in mid to deep stretch and prevailed under steady handling. FOCUS POINT broke sharply to set the early pace, was challenged heading into the backstretch and relegated to a prompting position along the inside GIANT VALLEY, argued with that one down the backstretch and around the far turn, drifted out a path leaving the far turn, continued to vie between that one and the eventual winner through the lane, drifted out a bit in mid-stretch and yielded late. GIANT VALLEY was caught three wide on the first turn and eagerly moved up to vie for the lead outside FOCUS POINT, drifted out leaving the far turn and continued to drift out through the lane while weakening inside the final furlong. BE MY FRANKENSTEIN was guided inside prior to the first turn and saved ground settling off the pace along the rail, advanced when shifting off the rail leaving the backstretch, split foes at the top of the lane but had no significant late rally. TANGO KID was floated five wide on the first turn, obtained good position stalking the pacesetters and eventual winner in the clear, went three wide on the far turn but was empty late. TIZAWONDERFULLIFE angled to the rail soon after the start, tracked front that vantage point, tired. LIZARD'S REPENT was caught four wide on the first turn, raced toward the rear and wide down the backstretch, going three wide on the far turn, never threatened. GULF WIND was no factor. EL COBRE raced off the inside, failed to menace.
